Performing Arts Scholarship

Each year a select number of Performing Arts Scholarships may be awarded to current and external students entering Years 5 to 11.

The scholarship remission amount will be at the discretion of the Principal and applies to Tuition Fees only. Other charges, such as the annual Fixed Charge and ICT Levy are to be met by the applicant parents/guardians.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for a Performing Arts Scholarship, applicants must demonstrate:

- A minimum of four years dance training.
- A strong academic record and a proven ability to perform at an elite level.
- For Junior School applicants commencing in Years 5 and/or 6 in 2026, they must demonstrate outstanding ability and present two to three of the skill criteria mentioned under the application process.

APPLICATION

To apply for a Performing Arts Scholarship please submit copies of the following documents with the completed application form:

- Copy of two most recent academic reports
- Copy of most recent NAPLAN
- If your daughter is a scholarship holder at her current school, a copy of the current scholarship offer/conditions

In addition, please provide copies of the following applicable documents:

- Academic certificates of achievement and awards (for example, national testing, debating and public speaking)
- References from school teachers, Performing Arts teachers or mentors
- Evidence of leadership roles within current school or community
- Evidence of accreditation in the Performing Arts, such as dance or drama at a high level
- Evidence of awards received and relevant exams completed
- Any other relevant documents that will support the application
- Small photograph of the applicant

APPLICATION PROCESS

Performing Arts Scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls and continue a Performing Arts subject through to Year 12. The continuation of the scholarship is dependent on the recipient making good academic progress, actively participating in the School's co-curricular activities related to their specialty, maintaining high conduct standards, and an expectation to seek out leadership roles within the School. The applicant will also undertake an annual review with the Principal, Head of Sub-School, and Head of Arts.

A shortlist of applicants will be invited to audition and interview with the Head of Arts and Principal.

If applying for Year 5 or 6 entry in 2026:

The applicant must present two genres of dance, AND one or two of the following:

- An age-appropriate monologue no longer than 3 minutes in duration and/or
- A song presented in the style of musical theatre (backing track to be provided by the applicant)

If applying for entry into Year 7 to 11 in 2026:

The applicant must present two genres of dance.

The applicant has the option to also present a song in the style of musical theatre (applicant to provide backing track) and/or present an age-appropriate monologue (no longer than 3 minutes in duration).
